
We benefit from the university's world-class academic expertise. As a not-for-profit organisation, we continually invest in education, research and services for schools.

## Progressive and flexible programmes

Our programmes and qualifications have four stages:

- Cambridge Primary (5–11 year olds\*)
- Cambridge Secondary 1 (11–14 year olds\*)
- Cambridge Secondary 2 (14–16 year olds\*)
- Cambridge Advanced (16–19 year olds\*)

Schools can offer all stages of our international education programmes and qualifications, or choose just one or two stages for specific groups of learners. Each stage builds on the learners' development in the previous stage.


